

## **Information to the collecting and processing of personal data**

*in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation; "GDPR")*

### **The controller of the personal data and the purposes of the processing of personal data**

Antisemitic Incident Report Form is operated by the Federation of Jewish Communities in the Czech Republic, ID No.: 00438341, with registered office at Prague 1, Maiselova 250/18, phone: 224 800 824, email: [sekretariat@fzo.cz](mailto:sekretariat@fzo.cz), which is the data controller, for the purpose of monitoring anti-Semitic incidents in the Czech Republic and ensuring the possibility of further investigation.

The personal data processed, i.e. collected and stored in paper and electronic form, are exclusively personal data voluntarily provided by the whistleblower by filling in the Antisemitic Incident Report Form (hereinafter referred to as the Form). Consent to the processing of personal data is given by the whistleblower in the context of filling in the Form.

Only authorized employees of the Federation of Jewish Communities in the Czech Republic may access the personal data processed. Personal data may be disclosed in the event of an assessment of the incident report as justified, to public authorities, in particular to law enforcement authorities on the basis of the law, and possibly to authorities, institutions and other persons, if necessary for the processing of the report.

### **Your rights and data protection**

You have the right to:

- to withdraw the consent given at any time for the processing of your personal data, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing which was based on your consent prior to its withdrawal,
- to request access to, rectification or erasure of personal data concerning you, or restriction of processing,
- to object to the processing of personal data
- to data portability,
- lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection Pplk. Sochora 27, 170 00 Prague 7 [www.uoou.cz](http://www.uoou.cz)

You can exercise the above rights by submitting a request to the FŽO. In all cases where you exercise your rights, we will inform you of the measures taken within one month.
